2026 MULCH PRODUCTS



SPECIAL BLEND mulch (comprised of logs, branches + leaves):

High-quality, finely shredded mulch with a natural dark brown color.

CHOCOLATE mulch (comprised of logs, branches, and colorant):

With less leaf matter than the Special Blend, but colorant added, this mulch is highly resistant to UV fading from exposure to the sun and can hold a rich color for the entire season.

LEAF mulch (comprised shredded leaves):

Our leaf mulch provides many of the same benefits as regular wood mulches, including soil moisture retention, improved soil structure, and erosion reduction.

***Also, offering RAW WOODCHIPS and FIRST GRIND:**

Will provide same benefits of mulch, but will breakdown more slowly. Great for natural style walk/pathways or for ball & burlap nursery trees.

Mulch Benefits:

- Soil moisture retention
- Soil temperature regulation
- Reduces weed growth
- Prevents soil splashing/erosion
- Improves soil structure
- Prevents soil crusting/baking
- Reduces soil compaction
- Reduces mechanical damage to trees caused by lawn equipment

DYED MULCH RECOMMENDATIONS

Non-toxic:

The mulch colorants we use are non-toxic and non-hazardous. The products are specially designed so that they are not harmful to aquatic life or plant life. No protective equipment is needed to handle mulch that has dried.

Heat damage:

Mulch, regardless of color, produces a biochemical reaction which can produce a great deal of heat. The amount of heat varies but can be intense. This naturally produced heat can burn or damage small plants. Care is necessary to let mulch cool by spreading it before install or to prevent plants from coming into direct contact or near hot mulch.

Avoid color run-off:

Apply mulch when you will have at least 3 days and nights of clear weather with no precipitation to prevent color run-off. Leave at least 48 hours of drying time for the color to bind to the mulch after mulch application. There will be no color run-off after the mulch has dried. Mulch that has piled before it was dry may not be fully dry. Color run-off may occur.

Do not leave fresh, wet bulk mulch exposed to a downhill slope towards a waterway. This will result in color run-off and will cause discolored water. If mulch is delivered in bulk and dropped by dump truck, it must be applied and spread to dry. Do not leave piles of mulch unused. The inner part of the pile will be wet. Do not leave bulk loads in open trucks or other containers exposed to precipitation. Allow 48 hours to dry after the last day of application with all bulk loads. Do not apply during storms or shortly before or after rain or snow events to prevent run-off.

Avoid staining:

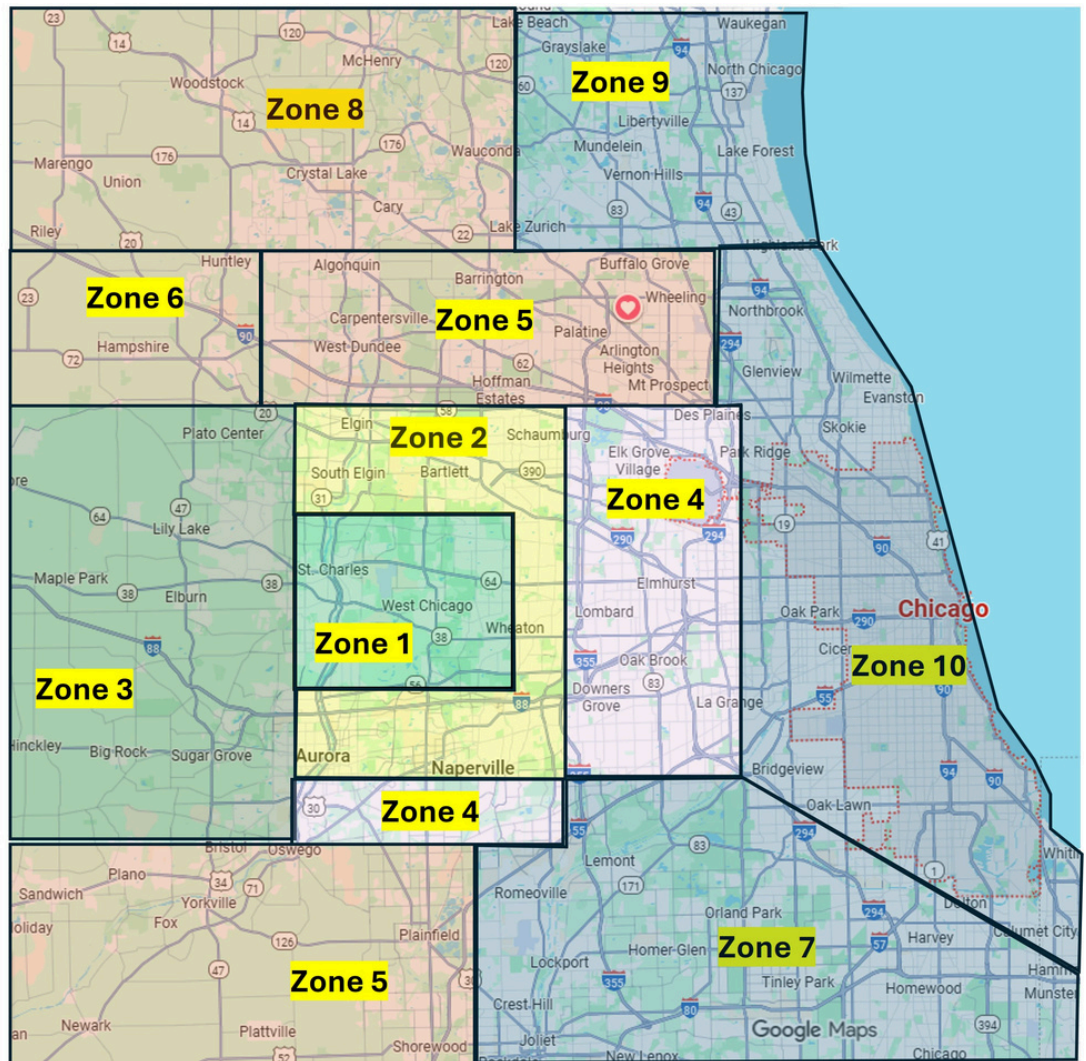
Mulch will stain concrete, clothing, and skin. To prevent staining of driveways or sidewalks, place tarp down before mulch is dropped. Wear old clothing and gloves when installing mulch.

MULCH ORDERING PROCESS AND PROCEDURE

To place a Mulch Delivery Order, you can:

Call to Order

The following information must be provided when placing a mulch delivery order:

- Company name
- Contact name and phone number (Site Supervisor)
- Type of mulch
- Quantity of mulch
- Requested Date and Time of delivery
- Job site address (shipment address)
- Drop spot map (Map indicating location where mulch is to be dropped)
- Payment information may be required

The mulch delivery order will be processed **after** you receive a confirmation from our office via phone, email, or fax. This confirmation will occur no later than 1 business day from the time the order was placed. If you do not receive confirmation, please contact our office immediately. Orders **will not** be shipped and/or dropped if there are inconsistencies in the order information and/or job site maps.

For any job site without an address or map, the purchaser must meet the delivery driver on site at the time of delivery; otherwise, the delivery will not be scheduled.

On occasion, it has happened that an order of mulch is either rejected or redirected by a client after it has been delivered. While we understand that sometimes things in the field change, you must understand that there are costs to be addressed. To cover the truck and operator's time and fuel, redirected or rejected mulch loads will be charged \$125.00/hour.

NOTE: Mulch will be dropped in one spot. We cannot drive off paved surfaces to drop mulch. Maximum size load: Wood mulch is 60 yards and Leaf mulch is 50 yards.
